Personal Watercraft National Pilot Program

- Learn how to safely use Personal Watercraft (Wave Runners / Jet Ski)
- Ride Personal Water Craft
- Two class options, morning and afternoon
- Twelve Scouts in each class per week
- Must be 14 years of age
- Must be a “Swimmer” to participate
- Written parental permission required



Lewis & Clark Scout Camp was selected to conduct a Personal Watercraft Pilot Program with the National Boy Scouts of America. Only five camps were selected for the 2010 camp season. The other four camps are located on the coast.



As part of this program, Scouts will learn how to safely operate and use personal watercraft. They will learn the first aid and safety requirements of the Water Sports merit badge. Participants will enjoy using the watercraft as they learn to ride the waves. Surveys will be given and evaluated to determine the success of the program. Currently this is a two year national trial program . Hopefully our program will become the standard for future and expanded watercraft use.

Personal Watercraft activities are NOT approved for any Boy Scout of America programs, with the exception of camp properties which have been selected to participate in this national pilot program.
