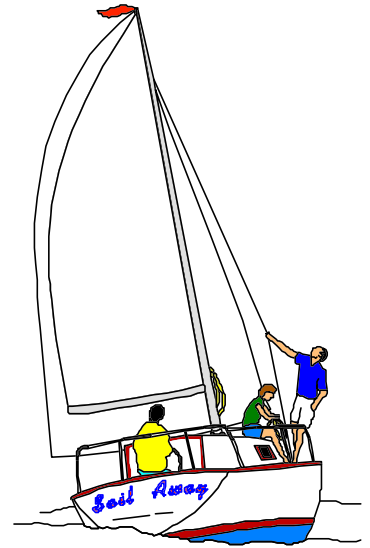


## **SPECIAL SAILING ADVENTURE OFFERED**

However, we will likely take in tours The National Fish Hatchery and Aquarium, Lewis & Clark Visitors Center, stay at a couple of Nebraska and South Dakota's nicer parks, explore astronomy if the sky conditions are right, and eat like a king. You will help crew and learn to sail the big boat like an old salt!
