

Scouting for Food Timeline

February

- Activities committee sets Scouting for food dates for fall and spring of next year.

August

- 2 - Sioux Trails article written and submitted
- 19 - Activities Committee design Scouting for Food patch

September

- 4 - Make arrangements with local food bank (date, time, drop off location, food bank help to inventory and unload food collected)
- 11 - Discuss Scouting for Food and order bags at your District Roundtable
- 11 - Each Unit appoints their local Scouting for Food chair person
- 18 - Map out each town for route to be canvassed by the Scouts
- 28 - Bags will be picked up by District Executives while they are at staff meeting

October

- 9 - Pick up bags at your District Roundtable
- 9 - Work with radio stations and local news papers to submit articles about scouting for food and what to look for in your community
- 23 - Radio PSA's and news paper articles should be on the air and printed
- 23 - Deliver empty bags to residents or to news paper to be delivered
- 24 - Make kick off fun for the kids, snacks, etc.
- 24 - Pick up food from homes
- 24 - Deliver food to local Unit collection area and count pounds collected
- 24 - Deliver food to local pantry
- 26 - E-mail Sioux council and local district executive the total number of pounds collected / number of people collecting food and order scouting for food patches.
- 26 - Submit thank you article to local news paper.

November

- 2 - Patch order form due.
